Sub :- Estt- I & CAD Department –Civil Service (conduct) Rules - Employees of the Department –Bringing pressure to the Government for postings as per Choice during transfer/Promotions
Certain instructions issued -Reg

It has been brought to the notice of the undersigned that several employees/officers of the department are bringing political pressures on the Government for posting them to a place of their choice during the transfers and also while effecting promotions. They are approaching public representatives and bringing the letter of recommendations to post them to a particular place which is causing, much embarrassment to the Government. Such acts of employees amounts to be unbecoming of Government servant and attracts disciplinary action.

In this connection, all the employees/officers are informed that as per A.P.C.S (Conduct) Rules, Rule 3 sub Para 2 “No Government employee shall behave in a manner which is unbecoming of such employee or derogatory to the prestige of Government and sub Para 3 “No Government employee shall act in a manner which will place his official position under any kind of embarrassment”.

Further as per A.P.C.S (Conduct) Rules, Rule 24 sub para 1 “No Government employee shall bring or attempt to bring any extraneous influence to bear upon any authority for the furtherance of his interest”.

Therefore all the employees/officers are here by directed not to violate APCS Rules their postings on transfers/promotions as per choice .Any violation of above order attracts disciplinary action as per CCA Rules.
