CORRIGENDUM

2. Brief Scope of Work

A broad scope of work is to carry out EIA Study/Obtaining Environmental Clearance from MoEF&CC for the proposed Irrigation projects:

1. Kaleswaram Project	18,25,700

3. Dindi Lift Irrigation Scheme	3,41,000

The Irrigation & CAD Department, Government of Telangana intends to hire a consultancy firm to the above mentioned assignments. Accredited EIA Consulting organizations, approved NABET/QCI for Category A Projects may bid for the projects with

additional Terms of Reference (TOR) and submit technical and financial proposals. The study will be carried out for the following two modules.

MODULE-I: Technical Proposal

A. Obtaining, ToR, from MoEF&CC (**only for the projects mentioned at serial No 3 &4 above namely Dindi Lift Irrigation Scheme and Palamuru Rangareddy Lift Irrigation Scheme. In respect of projects at serial No 1 &2, EAC of MoEF&CC has already approved ToRs of the projects on 03-03-2017**))

B. EIA Study, Public Hearing and Obtaining Environmental Clearance from MoEF&CC (**for all above projects**)

MODULE-II – Financial Proposal

Module -I A: Obtaining ToR from MoEF&CC: (only for the projects mentioned at serial No 3 &4 above namely Dindi Lift Irrigation Scheme and Palamuru Rangareddy Lift Irrigation Scheme.)

The brief Scope of Services for obtaining ToR from MoEF&CC is as follows:

- Kick off meeting and initial discussions with Client on study requirements, collection of available data / reports
- Site visit and Reconnaissance survey - secondary data collection as per the study requirement
- Preparation of Draft Form-1 and Draft Terms of Reference (ToR) for conducting EIA study
- Preparation of Prefeasibility Report in MoEF&CC prescribed format
- Preparation of Final Form-1 and ToR for conducting EIA Study based on observations/suggestions from client for onward submission to EAC, MoEF&CC.
- Preparation of presentation to be given to EAC, MoEF&CC during finalization of ToR
- Technical assistance to Client during appraisal of project seeking approval of ToR .

Module-IB: The brief scope of work for carrying out the EIA study (for all above projects).



MODULE-II – Financial Proposal:

Lump sum amount in Indian Rupees shall be quoted for each project separately in a sealed cover.

3. Qualification Criteria

- **Introductory letter on letter head (with complete contact details – Name of contact person, mailing address, telephone, fax, email etc.); explaining how the organization is best to deliver the task.**
- **Organization profile.**
- **Last three years audited annual report and three years financial statement.**
- **Short note along with photographs on similar projects taken up by the consultant organization.**
- **Copy of valid certificate of accreditation issued by Quality Council of India / National Accreditation Board for Education & Training.**
- **The firm should have annual turnover of at least Rs.2.0 Crores during any one year from last three financial years.**
- **The selection of consultant organization is based on Quality & Cost Based Selection (QCBS) procedure.**
